At a Glance

- **Mission:** To significantly enhance and expand student life on campus as ACP grows toward its strategic goal of 1,400 total students in a diverse academic environment by 2007 – an increase of 100 percent over the student body in Fall 2001, when approximately 700 students were enrolled in a single field of study.
- **Vision:** At the heart of the ACP and University Heights Association campuses, the Student Center will be a hub for students at ACP and the College's UHA partner institutions – Albany Law School, Albany Medical Center and The Sage Colleges. The bookstore and cafeteria will serve students from all four schools. The auditorium will be a community resource for lectures and performances.
- **Amenities:** The 54,000-square-foot ACP Student Center will feature numerous amenities for students and the entire ACP and UHA communities, including:
 - A 500-seat auditorium/theater that can be converted into two 250-seat lecture halls.
 - A 350-seat cafeteria with food court-style service, a 50-seat mezzanine, 40-seat private dining room, coffee shop and convenience store.
 - A 5,000-square-foot bookstore serving all four UHA schools.
 - A game room and offices for ACP student organizations.
 - Office and meeting rooms for the ACP Office of Student Affairs.
- **Design features:** The unique 1,800-square-foot angular glass atrium will provide a signature design element greeting visitors. The west wall overlooking the open UHA quad will be constructed of large windows opening onto the cafeteria, providing a bright and inviting environment inside and out.
- **Construction budget:** \$11 million
- **Completion date:** January 2006
